Dear Parents/Carers

### This Week

This week, we have been learning about the Sutton Hoo Anglo Saxon discovery in History and using variables to code in Scratch! The children are very computer literate!

### Next week

English: We shall be writing a narrative piece inspired by, 'The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane.'

Maths: Children will be starting a new topic on Perimeter and length whilst others will be working on the fraction topic.

### Homework

New spelling words, as well as English homework, will be given to the children on Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> January for completion and a spelling test on Monday 26<sup>th</sup> January. Please also encourage your child to practise their times table facts.

**Reading** – Please could we ask that an adult signs the children's yellow reading record to confirm that they have completed their weekly reading homework. There should be five entries per week in the reading record but only one signature is required from an adult. This will be checked by their teacher in their weekly library session.

You will be sent further communication next week about how and when to book an appointment for one of the two evenings (27<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> January). If your child has a different Maths teacher, there will be an opportunity for you to meet with them later in the term.

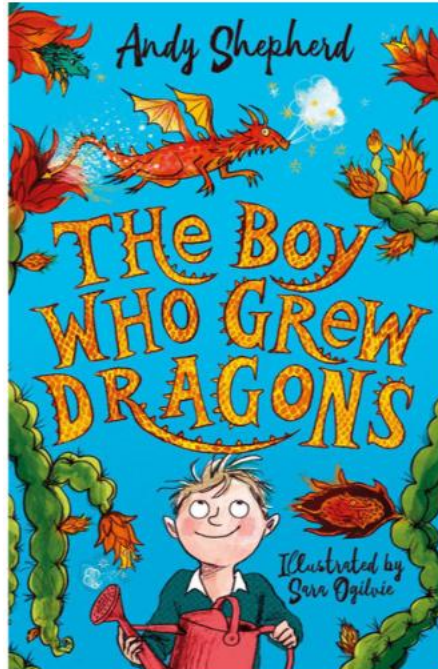
Please could we ask that your child brings a glue stick into school as we use these most days and they are a very welcome addition to pencil cases!
