Dear Parents/Carers,

The children have been working hard on our Christmas play this week. They've learnt some of the songs well and some children have learnt their script lines. Please remember that all the songs and lyrics are on Google Classroom for the children to practise.

## Next week:

In English, we will be writing a descriptive setting, based on our text, 'The Tin Forest.'

In Maths:

Miss Atkinson's set will be working on addition and subtraction methods.

Miss Malone's and Mrs Garland/Mrs Robert's sets will be continuing with the multiplication unit.

Please spend as much time as possible revising times tables with your children and encourage them to log on to times tables rock stars!

## Homework:

This week, an English sheet has been set on the present perfect tense.

Reading - Children are to read every night for 10-20 minutes. The title of the book and page numbers read over the course of the week should be recorded in their yellow reading record. This can be done each time the child reads, e.g.: 1- 5, 6-8 or as one entry, e.g.: 12-50, and parents/ carers are required to sign the reading record once per week. Big Cat and Library books can be changed during the class Library Session.

Spelling- Spellings will be given out on Tuesday and tested on Monday. Each week, the children will bring home a spelling sheet. [The children should complete the sheet by writing each word three times. They will then need to choose 5 words from the spelling list and write 5 spelling sentences in their orange homework book.](#)

## Book recommendation:

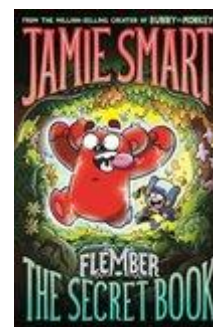
### **Flembert: The Secret Book**
