In English, we will be writing our very own superhero story!

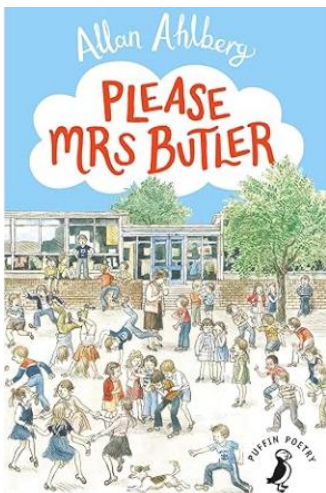
In Maths, all sets will be working on multiplication and division. Please help support your child by practicing times tables at home as often as you can.

Homework:

This week, the children have been set English homework focusing on punctuation. This is due in on Monday 12th January.

Reading - Children are to read every night for 10-20 minutes. The title of the book and page numbers read over the course of the week should be recorded in their yellow reading record. This can be done each time the child reads, e.g.: 1- 5, 6-8 or as one entry, e.g.: 12-50, and parents/ carers are required to sign the reading record once per week. Big Cat and Library books can be changed during the class Library Session.

Spelling- Spellings were handed out on Tuesday and will be tested on Monday 12th January. Please ensure the sheet is completed by writing each word three times. The children will then need to choose 5 words from the spelling list and write 5 spelling sentences in their orange homework book. This is an important part of the homework set each week.
