

# Year 3 Newsletter 16.1.26

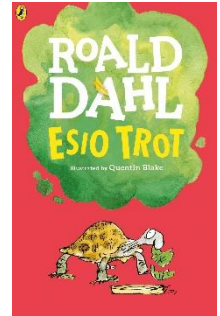
Dear Parents/Carers,

In English, we will be starting our unit of work based around writing adverts. We will be advertising a tortoise catcher inspired by Esio Trot by Roald Dahl.



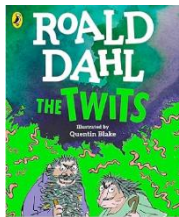
