Dear Parents/Carers,

It has been an enjoyable week in Year 3 and the children have been busy working hard. It has been great to see so many children engaging in their reading and times tables practise at home, we are grateful for the support.

Next week:

In English, we will be continuing to write our own persuasive advert!

In Maths, Miss Atkinson's set will be working on multiplication and division. Mrs Garland/Mrs Robert and Miss Malone's sets will be working on length and perimeter.

Please continue to support your child by practicing times tables at home as often as you can.

Homework:

This week, the children have been set English homework focusing on Oracy. The children will have two weeks to complete the task. It is due in on Monday 2nd February 2026.

Reading - Children are to read every night for 10-20 minutes. The title of the book and page numbers read over the course of the week should be recorded in their yellow reading record. This can be done each time the child reads, e.g.: 1- 5, 6-8 or as one entry, e.g.: 12-50, and parents/ carers are required to sign the reading record once per week. Big Cat and Library books can be changed during the class Library Session.

Spelling- Spellings were handed out on Tuesday and will be tested on Monday. Please ensure the sheet is completed by writing each word three times. The children will then need to choose 5 words from the spelling list and write 5 spelling sentences in their orange homework book. This is an important part of the homework set each week.
