Dear Parents/Carers,

Thank you for attending parents' evening this week. It was great to see so many of you and inform you of your child's progress this year.

## Next week:

In English, we will starting to write a recount, based on a virtual trip to Australia Zoo.

In Maths, Miss Atkinson's set will be working on multiplication and division. Mrs Garland/Mrs Robert and Miss Malone's sets will be working on length and perimeter.

Please continue to support your child by practicing times tables at home as often as you can.

## Homework:

This week, the children have been set Maths homework. It is due in on Monday 9th February 2026.

Reading - Children are to read every night for 10-20 minutes. The title of the book and page numbers read over the course of the week should be recorded in their yellow reading record. This can be done each time the child reads, e.g.: 1- 5, 6-8 or as one entry, e.g.: 12-50, and parents/ carers are required to sign the reading record once per week. Big Cat and Library books can be changed during the class Library Session.

Spelling- Spellings were handed out on Tuesday and will be tested on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> February 2026. Please ensure the sheet is completed by writing each word three times. The children will then need to choose 5 words from the spelling list and write 5 spelling sentences in their orange homework book. This is an important part of the homework set each week.

## Book Recommendation:

This week, Mrs Robert recommends Steve Backshall's 'Deadly 60'. It is a good idea to make sure your child reads a mixture of fiction and non-fiction books so this non-fiction book is full of facts about interesting animals.
