Dear Parents/Carers,

After half term:

In English, we will be continuing our book 'Into the Forest' and the children will be writing a formal letter.

In Maths, the children will be moving into Maths sets next week.

Miss Atkinson's set will be working on addition and subtraction methods.

Miss Malone's and Mrs Garland/Mrs Robert's sets will be finishing the addition and subtraction unit and moving onto multiplication.

DATE CHANGE:

The new date for the Year 3 Christmas Nativity Play is Monday 15th December at 9.30am (previously Tues 16th Dec)

The performance on Wednesday 17th December at 5pm remains the same.

Homework:

This week, a Maths sheet has been set, which focuses on subtraction.

Reading - Children are to read every night for 10-20 minutes. The title of the book and page numbers read over the course of the week should be recorded in their yellow reading record. This can be done each time the child reads, e.g.: 1- 5, 6-8 or as one entry, e.g.: 12-50, and parents/ carers are required to sign the reading record once per week. Big Cat and Library books can be changed during the class Library Session.

Spelling- Spellings will be given out on Tuesday and tested on Monday. Each week, the children will bring home a spelling sheet. The children should complete the sheet by writing each word three times. They will then need to choose 5 words from the spelling list and write 5 spelling sentences in their orange homework book.

TTRS – A huge well done to Willow class, who won the TTRS battle over half term!

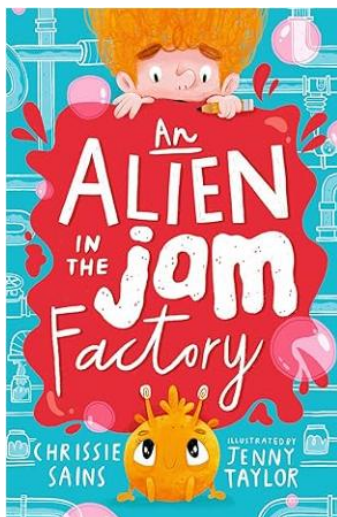
