This Week

This week, the children began Tag Rugby in Outdoor PE. In Maths, we have been completing arithmetic with a focus on addition and subtraction with exchanges, while some are finishing the unit of Fractions. In English, we have been writing a setting description from our book 'The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane.'

Next week

English: We shall be writing a poem based upon the poem The Treasures from the Sea.

Maths: Some children will be looking at the length and perimeter and some starting the second part of multiplication and division.

Homework

New spelling words, as well as Maths homework, will be given to the children on Tuesday 27th January for completion and a spelling test on Monday 2nd of February. Please also encourage your child to practise their times table facts and to read at home.

Reading – Please could we ask that an adult signs the children's yellow reading record to confirm that they have completed their weekly reading homework. There should be five entries per week in the reading record but only one signature is required from an adult. This will be checked by their teacher in their weekly library session.

Please ensure your child's PE kit is in school each day and that all clothes are **clearly labelled**. As the weather has now turned much chillier, please ensure the children have jogging bottoms and a long-sleeved top.

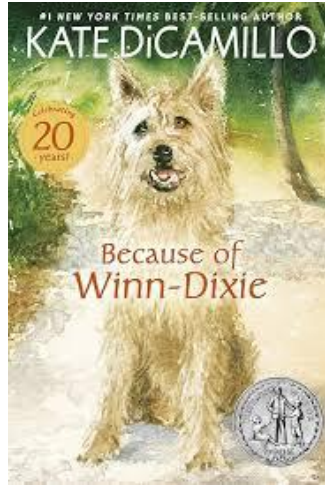
Please could we ask that your child brings a glue stick into school as we use these most days and they are a very welcome addition to pencil cases!
