This Week

This week, the children have begun Perimeter and how to find missing side lengths of a rectilinear shape. We enjoyed seeing many of you at parents evening to discuss the progress of the children since September. In science, children recapped their learning of pitch and the volume of sound using a decibel metre.

Next week

English: We are beginning a short unit on poetry based upon poems written by Valerie Bloom.

Maths: We will continue our unit on perimeter with regular and irregular polygons.

Homework

New spelling words, as well as English homework, will be given to the children on Tuesday 3rd of February for completion and a spelling test on Monday 9th of February. Please also encourage your child to practise their times table facts. The children will be delivering their oracy speech on Monday 2nd of February to the year group. Mr. Lewington and Miss. Cook will be the judges and will choose three students to go to the finals.

Reading – Please could we ask that an adult signs the children's yellow reading record to confirm that they have completed their weekly reading homework. There should be five entries per week in the reading record but only one signature is required from an adult. This will be checked by their teacher in their weekly library session.

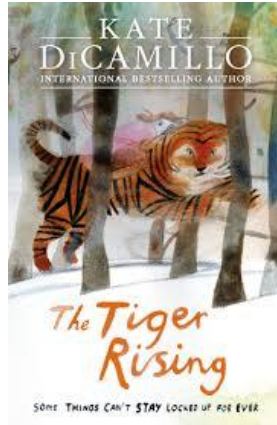
Please could we ask that your child brings a glue stick into school as we use these most days and they are a very welcome addition to pencil cases!
