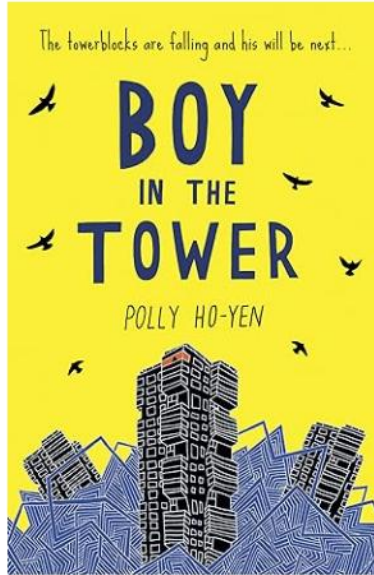
Please could we ask that your child brings a glue stick into school as we use these most days and they are a very welcome addition to pencil cases!
