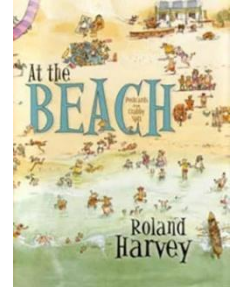
Dear Parents/Carers,

This week, the children finished writing their informal letter in English and enjoyed being part of our Whiteheath photo day.

## Next week:

In English, we will be starting our new topic on a book called At the Beach.

The children will be looking at postcards within this book. If you have any postcards at home, please send them in.



In Maths, we will be continuing our topic on addition and subtraction and starting formal written methods.

## Homework:

**There will be a Times Table Rock Stars battle between the classes. It will start this Friday at 4pm and finish the following Friday at 8am. The objective is to pop onto TTRS as often as you can in the week to earn points for your class by answering times table questions. The winning class will be announced on Friday morning.**

An English OR Maths activity will be given out on Tuesday and must be returned the following Monday.

Reading - Children are to read every night for 10-20 minutes. The title of the book and page numbers read over the course of the week should be recorded in their yellow reading record. This can be done each time the child reads, e.g.: 1- 5, 6-8 or as one entry, e.g.: 12-50, and parents/ carers are required to sign the reading record once per week. Big Cat and Library books can be changed during the class Library Session.

Spelling- Spellings will be given out on Tuesday and tested on Monday. Each week, the children will bring home a spelling sheet. The children should complete the sheet by writing each word three times. They will then need to choose 5 words from the spelling list and write 5 spelling sentences in their orange homework book.

**Please remind all children to complete the 5 spelling sentences as many were missing this week.**
