Dear Parents/Carers,

## **After half term:**

In English, we will be starting a new unit on writing instructions. Perhaps look at some instructions together over half term if you can – instructions for a board game, recipe etc.

In Maths, Miss Atkinson's set will be starting a new unit of work on Length and Perimeter. Mrs Garland/Mrs Robert and Miss Malone's sets will be starting a new unit on fractions.

Please continue to support your child by practicing times tables at home as often as you can.

## **Equipment:**

We will be sending pencil cases home over half term to be replenished. Some children are missing pencils, whiteboard pens and green pens.

## **Homework:**

This week, the children have been set grammar homework. This has been set on SPAG.com. Information about this has been stuck into your child's book. **Please complete this by Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> February.**

Reading - Children are to read every night for 10-20 minutes. The title of the book and page numbers read over the course of the week should be recorded in their yellow reading record. This can be done each time the child reads, e.g.: 1- 5, 6-8 or as one entry, e.g.: 12-50, and parents/ carers are required to sign the reading record once per week. Big Cat and Library books can be changed during the class Library Session.

Spelling- Spellings were handed out on Tuesday and will be tested, as usual on, Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> February. Please ensure the sheet is completed by writing each word three times. The children will then need to choose 5 words from the spelling list and write 5 spelling sentences in their orange homework book. This is an important part of the homework set each week.
