Dear Parents/Carers,

The children have settled back into the new half term well and have had a great week! It has been wonderful to see so many fantastic entries for our reading competition – some of the reading spots have been very creative!

Next week:

In English, we will be continuing our unit on writing instructions and will be writing instructions for how to make a mouldy monster roll!

In Maths, Miss Atkinson's set will be starting a new unit of work on length and perimeter. Mrs Garland/Mrs Robert and Miss Malone's sets will be continuing their unit on fractions.

Please continue to support your child by practising times tables at home as often as you can.

Homework:

This week, the children have been set Maths homework. **Please complete this by Monday 2nd March.**

Reading - Children are to read every night for 10-20 minutes. The title of the book and page numbers read over the course of the week should be recorded in their yellow reading record. This can be done each time the child reads, e.g.: 1- 5, 6-8 or as one entry, e.g.: 12-50, and parents/ carers are required to sign the reading record once per week. Big Cat and Library books can be changed during the class Library Session.

Spelling- Spellings were handed out on Tuesday and will be tested, as usual on, Monday 2nd March. Please ensure the sheet is completed by writing each word three times. The children will then need to choose 5 words from the spelling list and write 5 spelling sentences in their orange homework book. This is an important part of the homework set each week.

DT – Cardboard

We are looking for more materials for our DT topic 'Castles' that we will be starting this term. Please can you save any clean cardboard that you may have acquired (delivery boxes, cereal boxes, shoe boxes etc) and ask your child to bring it into school. Thank you!

This is a reminder that the children are welcome to bring in a snack to eat at breaktime. However, our school policy is that this should only be FRESH FRUIT or VEGETABLES.

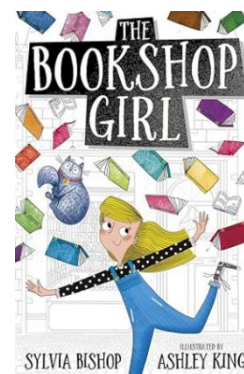
Unfortunately, we have seen other non-fruit/vegetable related items being eaten at this time.
