Next week:

In English, we are continuing our unit of work based around 'Ug: Boy Genius of the Stone Age' by Raymond Briggs.

In Maths, we will be continuing our unit of work covering Place Value.

Homework:

An English OR Maths activity will be given out on Tuesday and must be returned the following Monday.

This week, the children have been set English homework focusing on the use of, 'a or an'.

Reading - Children are to read every night for 10-20 minutes. The title of the book and page numbers read over the course of the week should be recorded in their yellow reading record. This can be done each time the child reads, e.g.: 1- 5, 6-8 or as one entry, e.g.: 12-50, and parents/ carers are required to sign the reading record once per week. Big Cat and Library books can be changed during the class Library Session.

Spelling- Spellings will be given out on Tuesday and tested on Monday. Each week, the children will bring home a spelling sheet. The children should complete the sheet by writing each word three times. They will then need to choose 5 words from the spelling list and write 5 spelling sentences in their orange homework book.

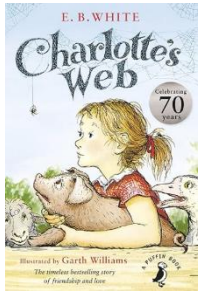
