We would like to wish you and your children a warm welcome into the Junior School.

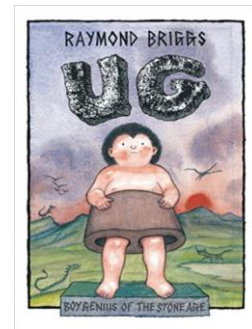
