Dear Parents/Carers,

The children really enjoyed meeting with the infant school children and loved wearing their pyjamas to school on Friday. They enjoyed 'The Masked Reader' competition and all of the World Book Day activities we did in school.

Next week:

The children will be recapping on their learning so far this term. They will also be making their castles in DT for a whole afternoon.

Homework:

Spelling- The children received spellings on Tuesday and will be tested on them on Monday 9th March.

We will be holding a school Spelling Bee competition. Therefore, please help your child to learn the Year 3/4 spelling words, ready for a test (only 10 words from the list) on Monday 16th March.

English homework handed out on Tuesday is due on Monday 9th March. There won't be any homework set on Tuesday 10th March – just for this week.

Reading - Children are to read every night for 10-20 minutes. The title of the book and page numbers read over the course of the week should be recorded in their yellow reading record. This can be done each time the child reads, e.g.: 1- 5, 6-8 or as one entry, e.g.: 12-50, and parents/ carers are required to sign the reading record once per week. Big Cat and Library books can be changed during the class Library Session.

DT – Cardboard

We are looking for more materials for our DT topic 'Castles' that we will be starting this term. Please can you save any clean cardboard that you may have acquired (delivery boxes, cereal boxes, shoe boxes etc) and ask your child to bring it into school. Thank you!

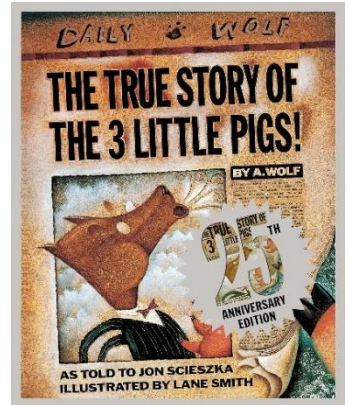
