Homework

Spelling words will also be given out on Tuesday 9th September for testing on Monday 15th September.

Please encourage your child to use Times Table Rockstars regularly to improve their fluency with multiplication.

Please ensure your child's Reading Record is signed by an adult. Children should be reading every evening for at least 15 minutes and we ask that a parent/carer signs at least once to confirm this homework has been completed.
