Next week

Homework

New spelling words, as well as Maths homework, will be given to the children on Tuesday 16th September for completion by Monday 22nd September. The homework consolidates work we will be covering in class. Please could you also encourage your child to practise their times tables facts during the week.

Reading – Big Cat login details have now been given to the children. They should have these stuck in their homework books or their reading records. The login details are newly generated this year and are specific to Year 4.

Please could we ask that an adult signs the children's yellow reading record to confirm that they have completed their weekly reading homework. There should be five entries per week in the reading record but only one signature is required from an adult! This will be checked by their teacher in their weekly library session.
