This Week

This week, the children took part in Safer Internet Day on Tuesday, focusing on the use of AI and its positives and negatives. During the afternoon on Wednesday, we did some activities linked to children's mental health. We thought about what makes us happy and the places we feel safe and belong.

There should be five entries per week in the reading record but only one signature is required from an adult. This will be checked by their teacher in their weekly library session.

Please ensure your child's PE kit is in school each day and that all clothes are **clearly labelled**. As the weather is now colder (and wetter!), please ensure the children have jogging bottoms and a long-sleeved top.

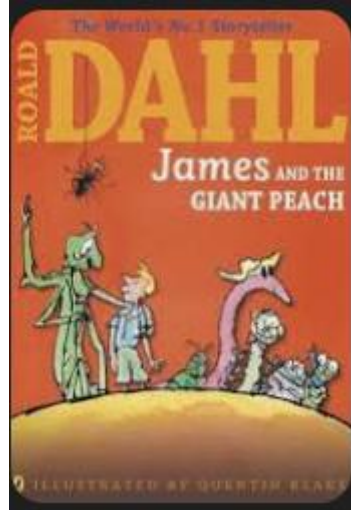
Please could we ask that your child brings a glue stick into school as we use these most days and they are a very welcome addition to pencil cases!
