This Week

This week, the children have worked very hard on their Spring term assessments in Reading, Maths and Punctuation and Grammar. The results of these assessments will be provided to parents on the children's report cards which will be given to them on Thursday 26th March.

Next week

In Maths, some children will be working on addition and subtraction of fractions. Some will be working on division and multiplication.

In English, we reading more of the book 'The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe'. We shall be focusing on inference and deduction questions related to the text.

Homework

New spelling words, as well as Maths homework, will be given to the children on Tuesday 17th March for completion and a spelling test on Monday 23rd March. Please also encourage your child to practise their times table facts.

Reading – Please could we ask that an adult signs the children's yellow reading record to confirm that they have completed their weekly reading homework. There should be five entries per week in the reading record but only one signature is required from an adult. This will be checked by their teacher in their weekly library session.

Next week, we shall be carrying out some investigations to mark British Science Week at Whiteheath. The theme is 'Curiosity – What's your question.'

We shall be having a DT workshop in Year 4 during the last week of term and ask that children bring in any empty boxes you may have at home. We are looking for boxes the size of teabag boxes for example, not so much cereal box size this time but anything is welcome!

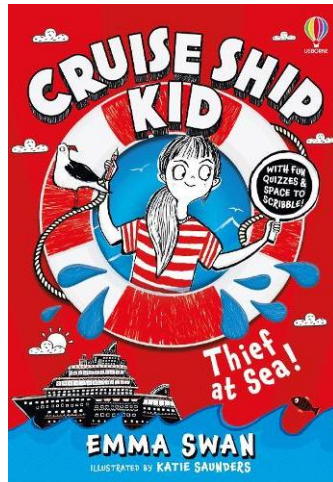
