Reminders

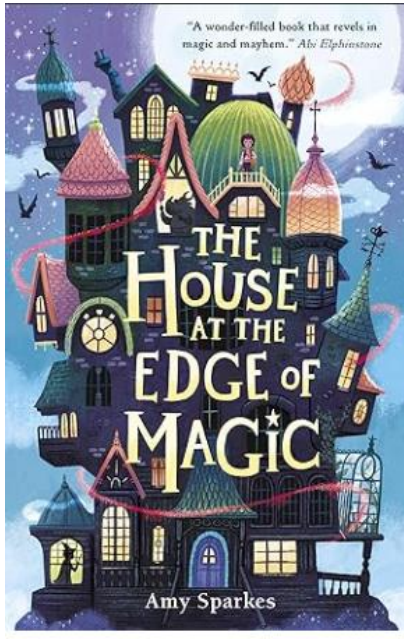
