Maths:

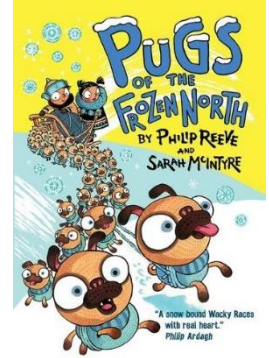
Miss Atkinson's set will be learning about fractions.

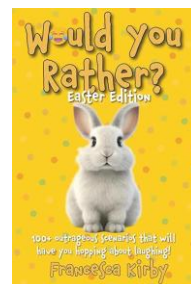
Dance Mat Typing
