If you would like to help walk your child's class to the church on the morning of Friday 12th December, please email your child's class teacher on their class email address.

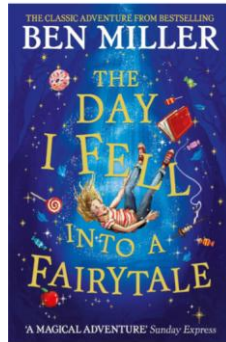
