### Maths:

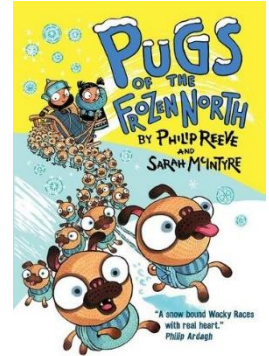
Miss Atkinson's set will be learning about fractions.

Please ensure that your child is recording the page numbers they have read each time they read so that we can see how much they are reading at home.

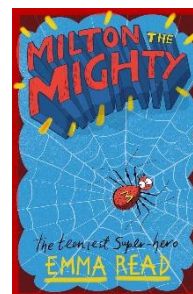
## Dance Mat Typing
