Maths:

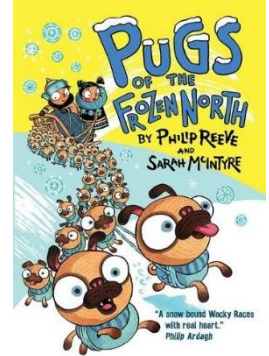
Miss Atkinson's set will continue to learn about fractions.

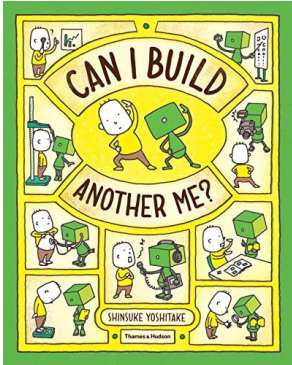
