## This Week

We have been focusing on grammar skills and learning about determiners and different verb tenses. In Maths, we have had a focus on arithmetic and completed our topic on decimal numbers.

In Maths, the children will be starting a new topic on money which follows on well from the decimals topic. In English, we will be looking at newspaper writing based on the Roald Dahl book, 'George's Marvellous Medicine'.

## Homework

New spelling words and English homework will be given out on Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> May for a test and completion by Monday 1<sup>st</sup> June (after the half term holiday). Please encourage your child to continue practising their times table facts as the Year 4 Multiplication Check will be taking place during the first two weeks of June.

## Reading

Reading records should be signed by an adult once a week. The children should record 5 entries per week, which includes the **page numbers they have read each time** and the title of the book they are reading. Please ensure that your child is recording the page numbers they have read each time they read so that we can see how much they are reading at home.

The school will be taking part in a Maths Morning with the theme 'Magic Maths'. The children will be taking part in a variety of maths activities in their classes.
