Please encourage your children to do their homework independently and if they have problems to come and see their maths teacher before the weekend so they can 'give it another go' over the weekend before it is due in on the Monday. Thank you.

Reading

Please ensure your child's Reading Record is signed by an adult. This is fine if they are proficient readers. All books can be changed during the class Library Session.

Please make sure that your children have a **full PE kit** in school all week. This is separate to kits they may bring in for after school clubs. These should be brought in in a separate bag. Thank you.
