This Week

We have been working on creating a website on the children's favourite hobby in our Computing lessons. The children have shown great understanding and mastery of the features of Google Sites! We also started a new Geography topic on Rivers. The lesson involved the children researching the different parts of a river and using new linked vocabulary.

Next Week

In Maths, the children will be doing some lessons on shape including work on quadrilaterals and lines of symmetry.

In English, the children will be editing and publishing their fantasy narrative text written this week.

Homework

New spelling words and English homework will be given out on Tuesday 16th June for a test and completion by Monday 22nd June.

Reading

Reading records should be signed by an adult once a week. The children should record 5 entries per week, which includes the **page numbers they have read each time** and the title of the book they are reading. Please ensure that your child is recording the page numbers they have read each time they read so that we can see how much they are reading at home.

Please ensure your child's PE kit is in school each day and that all clothes are clearly labelled. Both our PE sessions are outdoors during the summer term.

We have been reminding the children in school about the book writing homework task that has been set by Miss Lawrence. The deadline for this homework project is Friday 19th June.

Day 14	Revising – Read your book to someone at home. How could you make it even better?
15 th June	Revising – Bring your book to school and have a look at each other's to get some good ideas.
Day 16 - 18	Proofreading – Make sure your book is 'reader ready'. Check for errors and correct mistakes.
	Share your book with someone at home. Ask them what they think. Make any final changes.
Friday 19 th June	Bring your book into school to share with your class. Have a publishing party!
