Dear Parents/Carers

Year 4 children have been working very hard on their end of Year 4 assessments in reading, punctuation and grammar and maths this week. The results of these tests will be communicated to you in the children's end of year reports which will be out in July. This Week

In Science, the children learned about the digestive system and were able to write their own understanding of the process using scientific vocabulary. We have also been outside for our PE lessons practising athletics skills in readiness for the school's sports' morning in early July.

Next Week

In Maths, the children will be continuing with the shape topic and looking at angles and triangles.

In English, we will be starting work on a new book, 'The BFG' by Roald Dahl and looking at character descriptions.

Homework

New spelling words and Maths homework will be given out on Tuesday 23rd June for a test and completion by Monday 29th June.

Reading

Reading records should be signed by an adult once a week. The children should record 5 entries per week, which includes the **page numbers they have read each time** and the title of the book they are reading. Please ensure that your child is recording the page numbers they have read each time they read so that we can see how much they are reading at home.

Notices and Reminders

Please ensure your child's PE kit is in school each day and that all clothes are clearly labelled. Both our PE sessions are outdoors during the summer term.
